Consult your major advisor while completing this plan.

Students must file a preliminary plan of study with their major advisor prior to registration in their fifth semester. A final plan of study must be approved by the advisor and the department and filed online with the Registrar in the first four weeks of the semester in which a student expects to graduate. Once filed with the Registrar, changes to the plan may be made only with the consent of the major advisor.

At least 29 credits, numbered 2000 or above, are required to complete the journalism major. In addition, JOUR 1002 is a prerequisite for JOUR 3002, a required course. Students must have a grade point average of 2.0 or higher in the 29 credits constituting the major requirements. Pass/fail courses may not count toward the major. Only quality points and credits earned at the University of Connecticut may be used to meet this requirement, save where the dean of the college grants exception.
